Our littlest lion was born on 23 Oct 2020 to mum Kayla. Simba loves playing with mum and exploring new things.

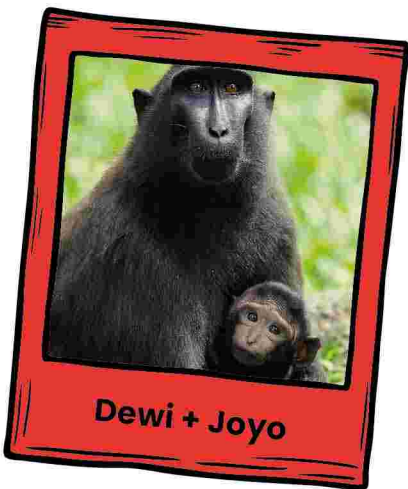


Malolo + Nupela

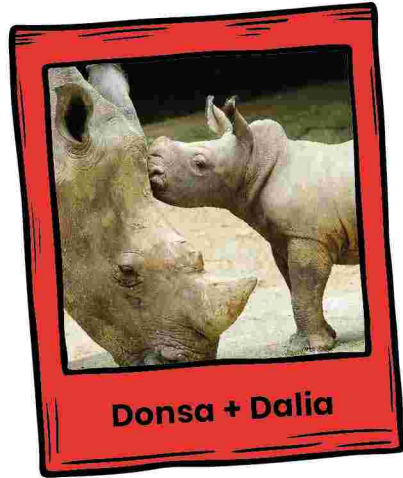


Dewi + Joyo

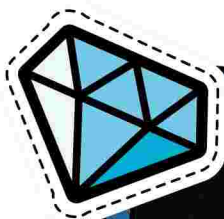


Bintang + Sakti

Malayan Tapir
